Why PMI-ACP®?

The PMI-ACP is evidence of your real-world, hands-on experience and skill as part of an agile team.

You can apply, if you have 1-3 years of project management experience.

You can demonstrate that your agile team experience runs deep. Beyond knowledge and comprehension, demonstrate experience and applying agile methodologies. The PMI-ACP® is registered against the ISO 9001 standard.

Prerequisites for the PMI-ACP®

- Secondary degree
- 21 contact hours of training in agile practices
- 12 months of general project experience within the last 5 years (a current PMP® or PgMP® will satisfy this requirement but is not required to apply for the PMI-ACP)
- 8 months of agile project experience within the last 3 years.

Audit

The audit consists of the following requirements:

- 2,000 hours (12 months) of general project management experience working on project teams
- 1,500 hours (8 months) of Agile project management experience working on project teams using Agile methodologies
- 21 contact hours of Agile project management education

The PMI-ACP Exam

- Testing locations
 - Multiple testing locations
 - Online Proctored Testing for your home or office (available 24/7)
- What you will be tested on
 - PMI-ACP spans many approaches to agile such as Scrum, Kanban, Lean, extreme programming (XP), and test-driven development (TDD), not limiting a practitioner to one agile approach
- Questions
 - 120 multiple-choice questions (100 scored and 20 unscored (pre-test) questions)
 - Unscored questions will not be identified and will be randomly distributed throughout the exam
 - 3 levels of questions (level 1: 33% of 120 questions; level 2: 12%; level 3: 5%)
- Time
 - 3 hours
